Each section was encouraged to plan special activities to promote public awareness of physics during the year.

The group broke into subgroups of four to brainstorm ideas that might be used. These were collected at the end of the session, and will be emailed to section reps later. Some of the ideas put forth were:

- * coordinate a measurement of the radius of the Earth using the Internet and schools in various locations
- * coordinate with math teachers since Einstein's birthday is the same as PI day, Mar 14
- * arrange for a sound bite/video/newspaper announcement on the anniversary of each of Einstein's three papers
- * create bumper stickers for school busses, physics teachers' cars
