AAPT will support, up to \$15 000, an online journal in physics education, available free to anyone. It is expected to be up and running in Mar/Apr of 2005. Alaska has petitioned to become a section. Alaska has met the requirements for a minimum number of members, a defined geographical area, and a section constitution. A vote will be held at the Council Meeting.

A motion was made to ask AAPT council for an increase in support for section reps to attend the Winter Meeting when a new section is added. Carried.

The Dodge building in College Park, first home of AAPT, was sold for a net cash flow of \$650 000. Of this, \$250 000 will be placed in the "Dodge Fund", whose

raison d'etre is to be determined. The other \$400 000 is to be allocated for AAPT projects.
